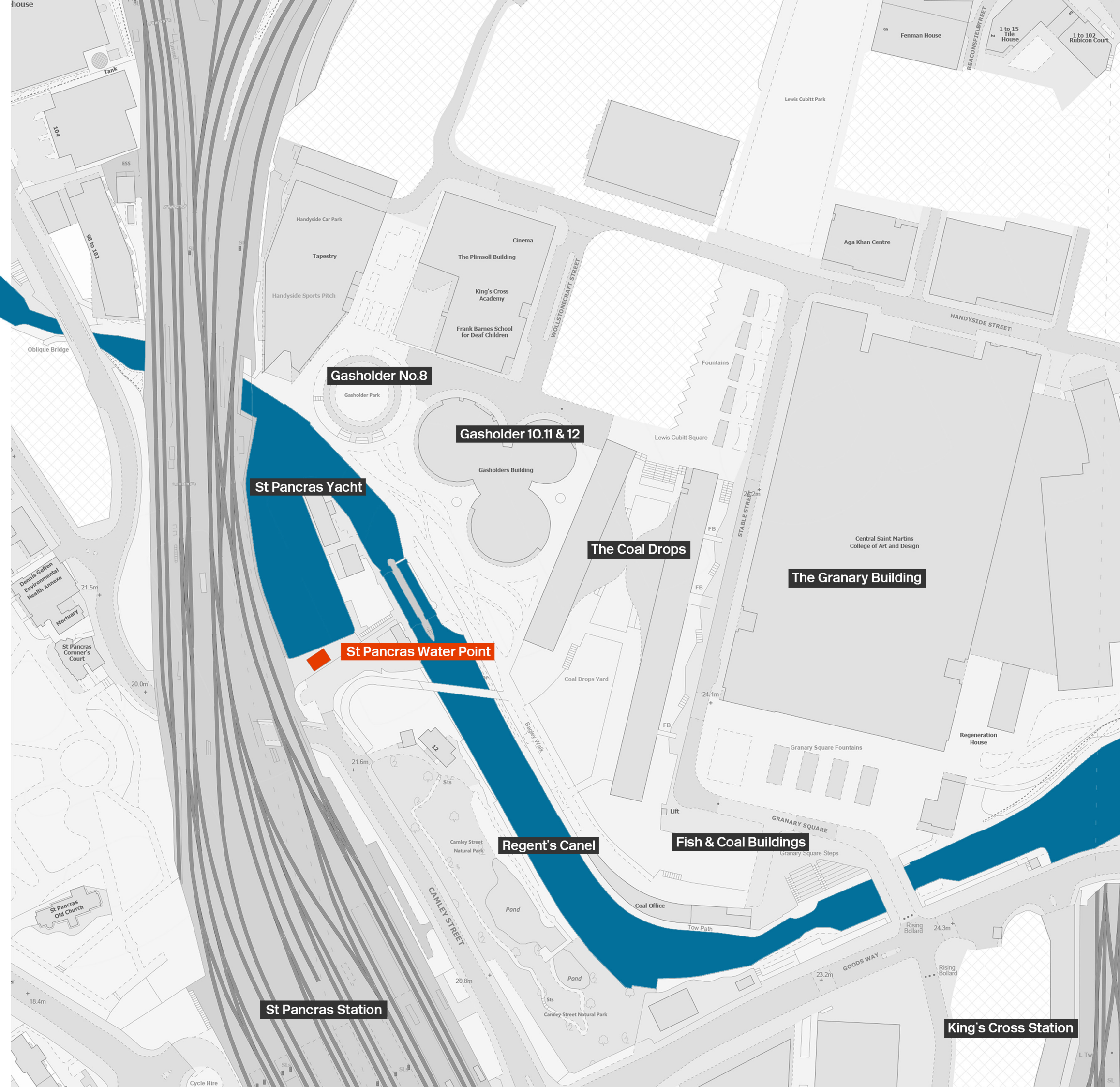


A Trainspotters' Library

Built in 1872 to supply water to the rapidly growing steam railway network at St Pancras, the Waterpoint is an extremely significant Grade II listed building.



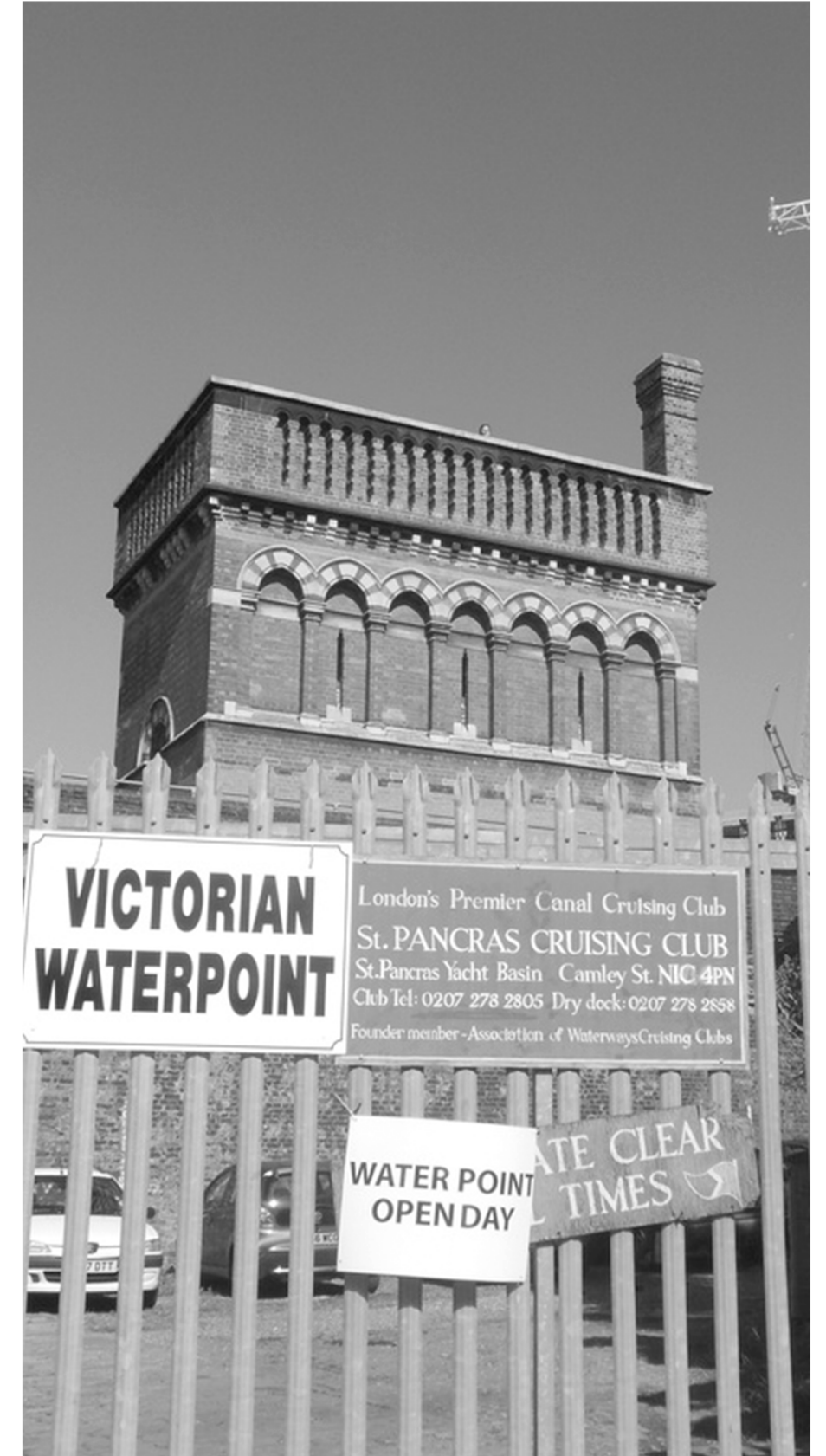

British Rail Corporate Identity Manual

Gerald Barney's symbol for British Rail initially encountered some hostile public reaction with one critic comparing it to 'a piece of twisted barbed wire'



The manuals, first issued in 1965, gave detailed instructions for applying the corporate identity to all aspects of business from train liveries and staff uniforms to stationery and station clocks (photos: John Maltby)
